### EXCURSION

#### Arusha National Park (40Min-1Hour Drive)

The park (137km<sup>2</sup>), has terrain ranging from open savannah through acacia scrublands to Afro-montane cloud and rain forest and Afro-alpine vegetation similar to Mount Kilimanjaro. There are several alkaline lakes and the spectacular Ngurdoto Crater. Mammal species include elephants, buffalos, various primates, giraffes and leopards. Hiking is allowed if accompanied by an armed ranger and the climb up Mount Meru is superb, often giving the best views available of Mount Kilimanjaro. At 4,556m, Mount Meru is the fifth highest mountain in Africa and is located in the Arusha National Park. You will spend the day driving through forest, glades and pans.

Picnic Lunch or Late Lunch in a hotel will be served.  
Later in the afternoon you will drive back to Arusha.

### Ngorongoro Crater (2-3 Hrs Drive)

The crater has a variety of habitats including grassland, forest and swamp. The lake on the crater floor is home to flamingoes and other species of birds. ### A DAY TRIP TO KILIMANJARO MOUNTAIN (1-2 Hrs DRIVE FROM ARUSHA TO THE GATE)

Please note, you will not reach the Summit as it takes 6-10 days to reach it.

After an early breakfast, drive to Marangu gate where the walk starts. You will spend the day walking through Kilimanjaro National Park appreciating the inique vegetation of the Africa's highest mountain. The walk passes through the lush vegetation of the mountain rain to Mandara Hut (2700m) and this is over 8 km which takes 3-4 hours.

You can also visit the surrounding area up to Maundi Crater.

Later in the afternoon, drive back to Arusha.

### Day Trip Tarangire National Park ( 2-3 HRS Drive)

Departing early in the morning for Tarangire National Park. At 2,600km<sup>2</sup>, Tarangire is far from being the biggest of the Tanzanian parks, but its unrivalled landscape of open plains, dotted with thousands of baobabs, is unforgettable. Tarangire is known for its baobabs, herds of elephant and plains game. This is one of Africa's little-known gems and should be on the itinerary of all lovers of wilderness and solitude. The game numbers are staggering: 30,000 zebra, 25,000 wildebeest, 5,000 buffalo, 3,000 elephant, 2,500 Maasai giraffe and over 1,000 fringe-eared oryx (gemsbok). Predators include lions, cheetahs and leopards and birders will want to look out for the endemic ashy starling, rufous-tailed weaver and black-collared lovebird. Your day driving through Tarangire National Park will ensure you experiences of unrivalled bliss.

Later in the afternoon you will drive back to Arusha.

#### Day Trip to Lake Manyara National Park ( 2-3 Hrs Drive)

Departing early in the morning for Lake Manyara National Park. This is one of the most diverse of Tanzania's national parks, a small (325km<sup>2</sup>) combination of Rift Valley Lake, dense woodlands and steep mountainside. Manyara is a birding paradise (more than 380 species), especially for waterfowl and migrants and the forests are one of the best places around to see leopards. Lions here are known for their habit of climbing trees. You will spend the day driving through Manyara National Park.
